Change of Venue for Weekday Masses

We will have contractors coming to replace the transept windows on both sides of the Altar. This work is likely to take 3 weeks.

We do not have a definite start date yet, so weekday Masses will continue to be celebrated in the Church until construction work starts. When this happens, we will post signs on the door to advise you that the weekday Mass (Tuesday to Saturday inclusive) will be moved to a venue at the Sisters of Mercy Centre (Hou Mana Wai Mercy Wellsprings) at 104 The Drive.

For the duration of this work the Mass Tuesday to Friday will be at 8am, while the Saturday morning Mass will continue at 9am. Please note the change to the Friday Mass time.

The 5.30pm Mass on Saturdays and 9am Mass on Sunday will not be affected and will remain in the Church.

Normal Mass times in the church will resume as soon as possible.

Coast to Coast Rosary for Life and Faith Saturday 3rd December at 3 pm



At Fatima, Our Lady asked the children to pray the Rosary every day. In these perilous times, this powerful prayer is needed more than ever.

Since 2018, the Coast to Coast Rosary for Life and Faith has been held to coincide with the March for Life. The March, which is held in Wellington, starts at 3 pm and winds its way through the central city and ends in Parliament

Grounds. At the very same time the March is in progress, people gather together all over New Zealand, to pray the Holy Rosary. After the March there is a final Coast to Coast Rosary in Parliament Grounds around 4 pm.

In the first instance we encourage everyone to go to Wellington to join the March. If you are not able to go to Wellington, the OLSH Pro-Life group together with the Legion of Mary will be leading the Rosary in our church on Saturday, 3rd December at 3pm.

November – Month of Remembrance

If you would like to have anyone who has died remembered especially in our prayers during the month of November, please write their name on one of the "Month of the Holy Souls" slips available in the foyer and place it in the purple box at the foot of the altar.



If you would like to make a Mass Offering and have a Mass said especially for the person during this month of the Holy Souls, please use the "Month of the Holy Souls" envelopes also found in the foyer and hand it to the priest or into the parish office, and a Special Mass will be said for that person. **Please DO NOT place any envelope containing your offering in the purple box. The box is for prayer intentions only.**

A full head count of all adults and children attending Mass in our Church is required by the Diocese of Auckland on all four weekends of November. At the same time as the Offertory collection, you may notice additional people carrying out this head count for us. The Mass count figures are very important for the forward planning of the Diocese and a requirement for the annual Diocesan report to Rome.
