#### Meetings

#### **Assigned works**

#### **Eucharistic Ministry**

6 out of our 8 active presidium members are commissioned Holy Eucharist Ministers. Holy Communion is taken every week (4\* fortnightly) to the following Resthomes and have included the numbers (on an average) at each Resthome who receive Holy Communion

- Ranfurly Retirement Village 3
- St John's Christian Hospital Trust\* (Pah Road) 6
- Arvida Aria Park Apartments and Resthome (Pah Road) 8

- Greenwoods House (Pah Road) 3
- Rose Lodge<sup>\*</sup> (Liverpool Street, Off Pah Road) − 3
- Parkside Village (earlier called Selwyn Heights) (Hillsborough) which we do jointly with Hillsborough praesidium). 8-10

#### **AND**

3 housebound ex-parishoners.

During the year we've not been able to return to Turama Resthome but have added

- Cromwell House\* to give Holy Communion to Sister Theresa Santos (and one ex-parishoner Genevieve O'Brien)
- Epsom South Resthome\* 1

We also pray with those who are not catholics in these resthomes (at their request)

#### Rotation of the Rosary Statue to homes to promote family prayer time

We take the statue of Mother Mary to parishioner's homes every fortnight to encourage family prayer time and to promote the rosary. Through this work we encourage parishioners to join either as active or to become auxiliary members. We've had more success in gaining auxiliary members and no success with anyone joining as active members.

- Sr Louise assists with the overhead projector at weekend mass when rostered
- Sr Louisa (while she was an officer) assisted with the Diocese Ethnic Chaplaincy ministry, parish safeguarding process and as Treasurer of the Senatus.
- Sr Marlene is a commentator and reader at weekend mass when rostered
- Sr Marlene and Sr Josie are Eucharist Ministers at weekend masses when rostered
- Our praesidium led the Stations of the Cross on Fridays during Lent and also lead the Good Friday stations of the cross in the parish
- Sr Annemarie visited the Abortion Centre during Lent
- RCIA program Under the guidance and training of Sr Louisa 2 candidates were brought into the Catholic faith
- Our praesidium led the Coast to Coast Rosary on 3 December in our parish.
